- 「Global Initiative of Academic Networks(GIAN) Programme」(以下「GIAN」という。)は、インド人的資源開発省主導の事業として 2015 年 11 月 30 日に開始。インド側負担により(上限有り)、世界の一流機関から、教授、研究者、科学者等を 1～2 週間インドの高等教育機関に招へいし、現地の学生を指導してもらう。
- 募集分野は 13 分野(①Architecture, Design, Planning and Heritage、②Chemical, Bio-Chemical & Material Sciences、③Earth & Environment Sciences、④Electronics, Electrical, Information & Communication Technology、⑤Humanities & Liberal Arts、⑥LAW、⑦Other Categories / Interdisciplinary Categories、⑧Life Sciences & Healthcare、⑨Mathematical & Computer Sciences、⑩Management、⑪Mechanical Sciences & Infrastructure、⑫Physical Sciences、⑬Social Sciences)。
- 公募に基づき、インド人的資源開発大臣と 13 分野の委員会において、採択コースを決定。これまでに、781 コースが採択され、うち 16 コースは日本のもの。
- コース(授業)は録画され、インド国内の GIAN 登録学生等にも中継又は後日配信される予定。
- プログラムへの申込みは、直接 GIAN ウェブサイトより(締め切り:2017 年 2 月 28 日)。

Global Initiative of Academic Networks (GIAN) Programme

I would like to draw your attention to an initiative of the Ministry of Human and Resource Development of the Government of India. Global Initiative of Academic Networks (GIAN) in Higher Education was launched on 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2015. The programme seeks to invite distinguished academicians, entrepreneurs, scientists, experts from premier institutions from across the world, to teach in the higher educational institutions in India. The Scheme envisages garnering the best international experience into our systems of education, enabling interaction of students and faculty with the best academic and industry experts from all over the world.

2. Under this programme the international faculty would conduct one to two week course at an Indian institution. The upper limit of overall expenditure allowed for each such course is US \$ 8000 for 12-14 hours and US \$12000 for 20-28 hours course.

3. A GIAN Implementation Committee headed by Secretary (HE), Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) and 13 Sectional Committees for 13 different disciplines (the disciplines are mentioned in the bottom of the website under Area/Section) have been constituted to finalize and approve various courses and also to decide on budget allocation. Till date 781 courses have been approved by the Apex Committee. Out of these 781 courses, 16 are by faculty from Japan. Nearly 380 courses have already been organized. Out of 380 courses so far conducted, 7 courses were organized by faculty from Japan.

4. Collaboration with over 38 countries is going on to attract the best international talent. All courses were video recorded and some of them were also live webcasted depending on the available infrastructure and consent of the foreign faculty. This enables others to view the content later through the local and national GIAN portal and the National Digital Library. Student/participants registration facility is opened in the GIAN portal for the students from all over India to register for the courses and more than 2200 students have already registered for the GIAN courses on the portal.

6. We would like to encourage as many Japanese faculty to participate in this GIAN Programme, which will foster academic and people-to-people exchange between India and Japan.
